Supreme Champion

Supreme Champion was awarded to JM&AM Lewis, Pentwyn, Llanwrdda who have been regular exhibitors at the event and this 6month old BBlue Steer later sold to the judge for £3,500.



Reserve Champion

The Reserve Supreme Champion also from regular exhibitors, was awarded to the 8month old Limousin Heifer from TM&EE Williams, Nant y Geifr Farm, Llanidloes which later sold for £5,000, and the first prize Limousin and Reserve Champion Steer from the same Vendor sold for £3,350.

A Heifer from Miss J Gilbert of Arley, Coventry was awarded 3rd prize in her class and later sold for £4,600.

1st prize Unaltered Heifer & Champion Unaltered

The 1st prize Unaltered Steer awarded to a Limousin Steer from BL&JE Griffith, Lower Penygelly, Kerry, Newtown and sold for £1,380 and the 1st Unaltered Heifer and Champion Unaltered exhibit was shown by Glyn Roberts, Tyn y Ffrridd, Rhyduchaf, Bala, with a BBlue Heifer which later sold for £1,700,

The 1st prize Charolais Steer was awarded to Bowen & Bowen, Penthrryn, Brooks, Welshpool releasing £2,500, and the 1st prize Charolais Heifer went to WA&ME Williams, Cefn Isaf, Bethel, Caernarfon selling for £1,020.



1st Prize Limousin Steer & Reserve Champion Steer

The 1st prize Limousin Steer which was also the Reserve Champion Steer was awarded to TM&EE Williams, Nant y Geifr Farm, Llanidloes which later sold for £3,350, and the 1st prize Limousin Heifer which was awarded the Champion Heifer & Reserve Champion from the Williams's of Nant y Geifr which sold for £5,000.



1st Prize British Blue Heifer & Reserve Chamion Heifer

The 1st prize BBlue heifer which was the Reserve Champion Heifer was also awarded to TM&EE Williams, Nant y Geifr Farm, Llanidloes and later sold for £1,950.



Best exhibit sired by a Genus Bull

The best exhibit sired by a Genus bull was awarded to DG&E Lewis, Cefncoed Mawr, Pumsaint with a Limousin Steer selling for £1,400, and the 1st prize Heifer was awarded to a Limousin Heifer from T&NW Roberts, Gorswen, Carmel, Llanrwst selling for £1,020.

Demand all through the sale was exceptional returning a Heifer average of £1,570 and Steers average of £1,468, with an Overall average of £1527.
