Also achieving one of the highest prices of the day was 'Annie' by A.D. Powell, Foyce Farm, Gladestry, Kington, 22 months. B/W.Reg. No. 329996. Sire-Myllin Jim (H.J.Francis). Dam-Denwyn Jess (J.Rees Denman). Annie was purchased by D G Owen of Llandrindod Wells for £4,567.50.

All three of these top priced dogs had been available to view working on the Bala Sheepdog website proving again to be a successful addition to the sale.

The demand for the quality dogs was very strong with a brisk demand throughout the sale, with buyers from America, Denmark and all corners of the UK securing an overall average on working sheepdogs of £2,096 with working bitches averaging £2,815 and £619.50 overall on the young dogs.
